

# Let Not Your Heart be Troubled - John 14

## Made in His Image

*Colossians 3*

*11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: **but Christ is all, and in all.***

*1 Corinthians 15*

*22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.*

*23 But every man in his own order: Christ the firstfruits; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming.*

*24 Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.*

*25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.*

*26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.*

*27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.*

*28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, **that God may be all in all.***

*Colossians 1*

*12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:*

*13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:*

*14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:*

*15 **Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:***

*Romans 8*

*29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did **predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.***

## Humility and Christ

*John 13*

*1 Now before the feast of the Passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.*

*2 And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him;*

*3 **Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;***

*4 He rises from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.*

*5 After that he poured water into a basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded.*

*John 3*

*33 He that hath received his testimony hath set to his seal that God is true.*

34 For he whom God hath sent speaks the words of God: for God gives not the Spirit by measure unto him.

35 The Father loves the Son, **and hath given all things into his hand.**

John 5

19 Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he sees the Father do: for what things so ever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

20 For the Father loves the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.

21 For as the Father raises up the dead, and quickens them; even so the Son quickens whom he will.

22 For the Father judges no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:

23 That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.

24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;

27 And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.

28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,

29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

30 I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

Luke 10

21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

22 **All things are delivered to me of my Father:** and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him.

Acts 2

36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, **both Lord and Christ.**

Matthew 28

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**

## **Our Father's Family**

John 14

1 Let not your heart be troubled: *ye* believe in God, believe also in me.

2 In my Father's **house** <G3614 - **household, or family**> are many mansions <G3438 - **a staying, i.e. residence**>: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

Mark 6

4 But Jesus said unto them, A prophet is not without honour, but in his own country, and among his own kin, **and in his own house.**

**In the Father's heart all are welcome to be a part of His family. This makes calling Him Father seem more understandable. The place that needs to be prepared is the heart of the believer to be willing to accept this truth.**

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

4 And whither I go ye **know**, and the way ye **know**.

**Christ was going to the Father by means of the cross.**

5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we **know** not whither thou go; and how can we **know** the way?

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

**The way to the Father, the truth of the Father, the life manifested from the Father (1John 1:2).**

7 If ye **had known** me, ye should **have known** my Father also: and from henceforth ye **know** him, and have seen him.

8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou **not known** me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Shew us the Father?

10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

### **The Holy One, the Spirit**

15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

16 And I will pray **the Father**, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

17 Even **the Spirit of truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither **knoweth** him: but ye **know** him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

18 I will not leave you **comfortless <G3737 - Fatherless>**: I will come to you.

19 Yet a little while, and the world sees me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

20 At that day ye **shall know** that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

**By being honest at what we see at the cross, we are brought to a knowledge of the Father's love. After seeing the Father we can begin to understand higher truth**

concerning the Son.

### Let Us Go from Here

21 He that hath my commandments, and keeps them, he it is that loves me: and he that loves me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

22 Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world?

23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.

24 He that loves me not keeps not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me.

25 These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you.

26 But the Comforter, which is **the Holy (One), the Ghost (Spirit)**, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Ephesians 4

30 And grieve not **the holy (one), the Spirit of (the) God**, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

27 Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world gives, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

28 Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: **for my Father is greater than I.**

**The Father has always had a greater capacity to forgive.**

29 And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe.

30 Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me.

31 But that the world **may know** that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. **Arise, let us go hence.**
