Salvation

Thoughts on Salvation

1 John 4:8, 16...God is love.

1 Corinthians 13:5...God does not keep a record of evil.

Matthew 1

21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people **from** their sins.

There are two types of sin we carry: What we have done to others and what others have done to us.

John 20

22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

23 Whose so ever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose so ever sins ye retain, they are retained (unto you).

Because thoughts produce feelings and feelings move us to action: We are saved from the sins we carry by being redeemed from all iniquity.

Psalms 130

7 Let Israel hope in the Lord: for with the Lord there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption.

8 And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities.

Acts 3

26 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

1 John 1

5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: 7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

Speaking of the sins committed against us.

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all <u>unrighteousness (g93 – iniquity)</u>. (Compare Luke 13:27).

10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Speaking of what we have done to others.

God so Loves the World

1 Timothy 2:4...God would have all men be saved.

1 Timothy 4:10...God is the Savior of all men.

1 John 2:2...Christ is God's act of mercy for the sins of the world

Hebrews 2:9...Christ tasted death for every man.

John 1:29...Behold the Lamb of God, which takes away the sin of the world.

John 3:15-17...Whosoever believes can have eternal life. God would save the world.

John 17:3...Knowing God is eternal life.

God's Wrath

Romans 1

18 For the wrath of God **is revealed from heaven** against all ungodliness and <u>unrighteousness</u> (g93 – iniquity) of men, who hold (g2722 – restrain) the truth in <u>unrighteousness</u> (g93 – iniquity);

19 Because that which may be known of God is manifest **in** them; for <u>God hath showed (g5319 –</u> made apparent) it unto them.

Job 4

17 Shall mortal man be more just than God? -- shall a man be more pure than his maker?

20 (For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are <u>clearly seen (g2529 – clear as crystal)</u>, <u>being understood (g3539 – considered)</u> by the <u>things that are made</u> (g4161 – a <u>workmanship - used twice in NT...Ephesians 2:10)</u>, even his eternal <u>power (g1411 – ability)</u> and Godhead;)

Power and Godhead = power and rank or ability and divinity

so that they are without excuse:

21 Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Ephesians 4

- 17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as -- other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,
- 18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:
- 19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.
- 20 But ye have not so learned Christ;
- 21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:
