Travail

Many people anguish over the truth of Christ's birth in eternity passed, just as the Jews struggle with the fact that Jesus is the Messiah. All of us need to bring forth the man child in our heavenly understanding.

John 16:21 KJV

21) *A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.*

After we bring forth the man child we struggle again. Our travail is in helping others see the truth we have realized. This is the labor we remember.

Galatians 4:19 KJV

19) *My little children, of whom **I travail in birth again until Christ be formed in you,***

Isaiah 66:5-9 KJV

- 5) *Hear the word of the LORD, ye that tremble at his word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but he shall appear to your joy, and they shall be ashamed.*
- 6) *A voice of **noise (h7588 – uproar)** from the city, a voice from the temple, a voice of the LORD that rendereth recompence to his enemies.*
- 7) ***Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child.***
- 8) *Who hath heard such a thing? who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? or shall a nation be born at once? for **as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children.***

Zion Defined: Heb 12:22-24

- 22) *But ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels,*
 - 23) *To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,*
 - 24) *And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.*
- 9) *Shall I bring to the birth, and not cause to bring forth? saith the LORD: shall I cause to bring forth, and shut the womb? saith thy God.*

The Gentiles First

The children of Zion are those who believe the truth of God's love as proclaimed by Zion. God's love is proven true as an accurate depiction of Calvary is given...*For God so loved the world He gave His only begotten Son.*

The children of Zion, today, are first the Gentile, then the Jew.

Romans 11:25-27 KJV

- 25) *For I would not, brethren, that ye should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, **until the fullness of the Gentiles be come in.***
- 26) *And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, **There shall come out of Sion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob:***
- 27) *For this is my covenant unto them, when I shall take away their sins.*

This prophecy, taken from Isaiah 59:20-21, is the testimony of Jesus given in Revelation chapters one through sixteen (Revelation Book 1). To understand this truth is to possess the spirit of prophecy.

Revelation 19:10 KJV

- 10) *And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: **for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.***

Revelation 12 – Gentiles and Jews

Revelation 12:1-5 KJV

- 1) *And there appeared a great **wonder (g4592 – sign)** in heaven; a **woman clothed with the sun**, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:*
- For the woman to be clothed with the Sun, she would have already brought forth the man child within her own mindset. Satan has been cast down and she is walking in the fullness of God's love.**
- 2) *And she being with child cried, **travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.***
- Her travailing comes when trying to help someone else see the truth.**

3) *And there appeared another **wonder (g4592 – sign)** in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads.*

The dragon is in the mind of the Jew. The dragon is self and has not yet been cast down by the Jew.

4) *And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.*

This is in the mind of the Jew who is hearing Zion proclaim the gospel.

5) ***And she brought forth a man child**, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne.*

When the Jew believes the truth of the gospel , Christ is caught up into their heavenly understanding

6) *And the woman fled into the wilderness, where she hath a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and threescore days.*

The woman who flees into the wilderness is the Jew. They have never been in this land, or way of thinking, before. The place prepared of God is the bible. Zion will feed her for 1260 days.

1260 Days

$$10 \times 7 \times 6 \times 3$$

10 = God's understanding

7 = a fullness

6 = man

3 = a completion

God's understanding of the three times we experience the fullness of self. The third time we experience the fullness of self we reach the fullness of God's love.
