

Preparing for the End

The Days of Noah

Matthew 24:36-42 KJV

- 36) *But of that day and hour knows no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only.*
- 37) *But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.*
- 38) *For as in the days that were before the flood they were **eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark,***
- 39) *And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.*
- 40) *Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be **taken (q3880-received)**, and the other **left (q863-to send forth)**.*
- 41) *Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall **be taken (q3880-received)**, and the other **left (q863-to send forth)**.*

These two words are used in Matthew 5:40

- 42) *Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.*

CF: Luke 17:24-37, 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

Pitched with Pitch

Genesis 6:11-14 KJV

- 11) *The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.*
- 12) *And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.*
- 13) *And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.*
- 14) *Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt **pitch (h3722-to cover)** it within and without with **pitch (h3724-a cover)**.*

Proverbs 13:7-8 KJV

- 7) *There is that makes himself rich, yet hath nothing: there is that makes himself poor, yet hath great riches.*
- 8) *The **ransom (h3724)** of a man's life are his riches: but the poor hears not rebuke.*

The Mercy Seat

Exodus 25:17-22 KJV

17) And thou shalt make a mercy seat (h3727 – a lid) of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof.

Hebrews 9:5 KJV

5) And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat (q2435); of which we cannot now speak particularly.

Romans 3:25 KJV

25) Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation (q2435) through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

18) And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid).

19) And make one cherub on the one end, and the other cherub on the other end: even of the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid) shall ye make the cherubims on the two ends thereof.

20) And the cherubims shall stretch forth their wings on high, covering the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid) with their wings, and their faces shall look one to another; toward the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid) shall the faces of the cherubims be.

21) And thou shalt put the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid) above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee.

22) And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat (h3727 – a lid), from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel.
